## Conducted 5,000 surveys among residents in The Auto Club Group territory

- o Fielding took place March 12 18, 2021
- o Utilized a proprietary online research panel
- Weighted by age and gender within state

### **Statistical Statement:**

The AAA Consumer Pulse™ Survey was conducted online among residents living in The Auto Club Group territory from March 12 – 18, 2021. A total of 5,000 residents completed the survey. Survey results asked of all respondents have a maximum margin of error of ± 1.4% points. For individual states (except ND), the maximum margin of error is ± 4.9% points. Responses are weighted by age and gender within state to ensure reliable and accurate representation of the adult population (18+).

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
